LifeScape Embarks on Journey of Hope for Children's Services



Our fundraising campaign is called the "Journey of Hope," because so many families have told us that LifeScape offers them hope for their child.

The current location of LifeScape's Children's Services was a cornfield when ground was broken in October 1950 for "Crippled Children's Hospital & School." Opened in March 1952, the building was designed as a residential school and rehab hospital for children recovering from polio. After the virus was cured later in the 1950's, the building and services evolved to serve children with other needs. It was added onto three times over the decades to meet the needs of increasing numbers of children, with diagnoses becoming more varied and complex. A few years ago, with mounting costs to maintain the old building, waiting lists, and no room to expand, the LifeScape Board of Directors began exploring options for future generations of children. A decision was made in 2018 to build a new children's facility and plans began, as well as quiet fundraising.

Our fundraising campaign is called the "Journey of Hope," because so many families have told us that LifeScape offers them hope for their child. The Journey of Hope has navigated the COVID pandemic, scarce land availability, and inflationary building costs, but we've always kept our mission in mind, "Empowering people to live their best life." Now, we are poised to begin building a new children's services campus!

In May 2023 we purchased ten acres of land in northwest Sioux Falls for our project. Not so long ago, it too, was a cornfield. It is on West 34th Street North and North Career Avenue, south of Benson Road and west of I-29. The new LifeScape Children's Services will be built in two phases, with room for future expansion. Phase I will include a 69-bed children's residential area, a 25% larger specialty school, an 18-bed pediatric rehabilitation hospital, expanded inpatient and intensive outpatient therapy space, and some administrative offices. Phase I will cost \$88.5 million, with \$80 million already raised. The Sioux Falls Chamber of Commerce has approved the project for a \$1.8 million Community Appeals Fund Drive, set for April 1 through July 31st of this year.

Phase II fundraising will begin as soon as Phase I is completed. It will include a gym, pool, community center, family rooms and visitation space, plus more administrative offices. A buyer is being sought for the current 26th Street Hospital & School property, with proceeds applied to the fundraising total. Phase III is for future expansion of children's residential space when needed.

LifeScape's two outpatient centers will remain at their current locations, as will Adult Services. We are continuing our commitment to improve and replace homes for the adults we support.

Some utility work has been completed on the land, and we hope to break ground in April. It is a 30-month process, so we anticipate a finish date of December 2026.

From Our Chief Executive Officer

Since the 1950's, LifeScape has been here when families need us in the care of their children, no matter what the child's age. Last year, we supported over 4,700 children and adults from a seven-state region. Our specialized staff treated over 700 individual diagnoses through our residential programs, two specialty schools, outpatient and inpatient therapies, day services for adults, and our pediatric rehabilitation hospital.

For many more families, the services they need could be years away. Current statics say one in six children will be born with an intellectual or developmental disability, and one in 36 children will have an autism spectrum disorder. Unfortunately, waitlists for residential care, autism evaluations and treatment, and even hospital placements range from six months to two years. A nationwide shortage of psychology professionals, nurses, and therapists increases these waiting lists.

Another challenge is supporting children in our aging building. It has been modified, added on to, and patched up for the last 60+ years. The children we support have continued to change as well, with higher acuity of disorders and greater use of technology to provide independence and safety. The limitations of the current children's facility on 26th street is adding years to the wait lists, even in areas where we have the staff and technology resources to meet demand.

We have purchased ten acres of land in northwest Sioux Falls to accommodate the design of a 185,000 square-foot facility for children, including residential, specialty school, specialty hospital, some outpatient services, and some administration. The facility will expand residential services from the current 60 beds to 69 beds in Phase 1 - a 20% expansion. The specialty school will expand by 25% to accommodate growth and absorb all children currently on waitlists.

We are grateful for the individuals who saw a need to care for kids 70 years ago and pulled together to make that dream a reality. Our gratitude continues to today's generations who see that need again and have stepped forward to make a difference for the generations who follow.

Community Partner: **Koch Hazard Architects**

Jeff Hazard's Vision Prevails with New Children's Services Design



Jeff Hazard was the CEO of Koch Hazard Architects from 1999 until his passing in 2019. He served on LifeScape's board for 21 years.

Long into the future, Sioux Falls will bear the mark of the late architect Jeff Hazard. When he died of leukemia in 2019, tributes hailed his work on many of the most creative and high-profile buildings in the area. Now, one of his last projects will start to take shape, the new children's facility for LifeScape.

Jeff was on the LifeScape board for 21 years, from 1998 until his death. When the need for better facilities to serve children at LifeScape became apparent, Jeff toured the current building to assess its future. His opinion was that the 70-year-old, landlocked building would fall further and further behind in meeting the needs of today's children. He believed the kids at LifeScape deserved a beautiful space with natural light, safe outdoor access, art, and open space for healing and creative fun. So, he donated his time to make the initial drawings.

"Jeff had a long-standing investment in LifeScape and all of their programs, building on (Koch Hazard Architects co-founder) Ralph Koch's involvement," says Brooke Wegener, Partner and Chief Strategy Officer at Koch Hazard. "He was a board member and advisor, readily sharing his talent and resources. Jeff believed that all people should have access to well-designed spaces, and especially believed in LifeScape's mission."

Although the project has evolved since his passing, elements of Jeff's initial design remain, as well as his philosophy for its design. Through challenges in land availability and inflationary costs, Jeff's firm, Koch Hazard Architects, along with the Omaha-based HDR architecture and engineering firm, have guided the new facility into a beautiful and practical design that will serve children for generations to come.

"We are proud to carry on Jeff's philosophy regarding community support," says Brooke. "Koch Hazard Architects and HDR (Omaha office) are continuing the journey with LifeScape to empower children and adults with varied needs."

Dave & Christine Billion Gift to Fund The Henry, Evelyn, & Danny Billion School

A \$5 million gift from Dave and Christine Billion will ensure that children at LifeScape will have a beautiful and state-of-the-art space to learn and grow.

The Henry, Evelyn, & Danny Billion School at LifeScape will honor Dave's parents and his brother Danny, who had cerebral palsy. When Danny was born in 1946, special education was decades away, but his parents wanted more for him.

Evelyn started a parents' group and found a nurse/therapist to help Danny and the other children learn. As polio increased the number of children unable to attend school, a grassroots group formed to build a "hospital school" in Sioux Falls. Henry was named to the board to help lead the effort, and when Crippled Children's Hospital & School opened in 1952, Danny was one of its first students.

"You work to help other people; that was a lesson that was learned by having Danny as a brother," says Dave. He says he felt double the responsibility in life, because others had their talents taken away out of no fault of their own. "So, you need to use the gifts God has given you," he says.

The Need Is So Clear

Growing up in Sioux Falls, everyone was aware of "Crippled Children's Hospital & School." It was where the kids who had polio lived and went to school, because their home schools weren't accessible for their crutches and wheelchairs.

I managed to dodge the polio epidemics of the late 40's and early 50's, and so did all of my friends. We were lucky—but for the kids who did get polio—Crippled Children's made sure they were educated and got the best rehabilitation care available.

As an adult, I served on the investment committee for CCHS for about a dozen years. I was pleased to work on various community issues with Dr. E.B. "Jon" Morrison, who was the Executive Director from its opening in 1952 until 1984. E.B. was a passionate advocate for the children and helped craft South Dakota's first special education laws. Through him, I got some insight into the great work being done there. I also became aware of how many kids were being treated and educated from all over the state and region. We were helping school districts from all over to fulfill their obligation to educate every kid.

I don't remember CCHS opening in March 1952, but I've watched it evolve over the years. As central Sioux Falls residents for the past half century, my wife Arlene and I have driven past the children's facility regularly and watched it evolve. We saw the building projects to expand the space as much as they possibly could. We saw the kids change—the disabilities became more significant, and many had multiple diagnoses and behavioral needs.

The current facility has been outdated and undersized for about a third of my life. Sioux Falls has done a great job meeting the needs of kids in every other area—educating and taking care of health needs—but kids with special needs are overdue for some attention and a new facility.

Now there is a campaign underway to build a new campus for children with disabilities. What attracted us to the project is that the need is so clear.

The team has studied facilities all around the country. The new facility will allow them to adopt best practices that have been identified in this field. It will allow us to take better care of the growing population of kids with unique needs and multiple diagnoses than we've been able to do in an aging facility.

The first CCHS was built by concerned citizens across South Dakota and beyond. It's time to do so again. If you haven't already made a gift to the LifeScape Journey of Hope Capital Campaign for the new children's facility, I invite you to join me in doing so.

We are grateful to the visionary leaders who gave our fundraising a strong start, committing \$80 million in support towards the \$113 million cost of the facility (Phase 1 is \$88.5 million and Phase 2 is \$25 million). We are grateful to our boards of directors for 100% participation and for the leadership of our campaign steering committee: Dan and Arlene Kirby and Tom and Barb Everist, John Rozell, Angie Haft, Nan Baker, Erin Horstmeyer, and Jeff Hilgenberg. We thank our lead donors David and Christine Billion, Dan and Arlene Kirby, Tom and Barb Everist, Carl and Marietta Soukup, Jeff and Trudi Nelson, Al Schoeneman, Susan Geyerman, Henry Carlson Construction, and several anonymous supporters! We are grateful to be approved for a \$1.8 million Sioux Falls Chamber Appeals campaign set for April -July 2024. After 30 years, MallWalk Continues
to Deliver for People at LifeScape

MallWalk turned 30 this year, and what a great celebration! On February 3rd, 34 MallWalk teams raised an astonishing \$101,842 for LifeScape's Needs & Dreams Wish List! (Contributions continued to roll in after the event, and at press time, that figure had grown to \$103,631.) Last year's total was \$78,477.

Auxiliary member Joan Olson came up with the idea for the first MallWalk, held in 1994. "We did have a good turnout our first year we thought," says Joan. "But after that we got sponsors, urged people to form teams, and the kids and their families got involved, and it really took off." Over the years, the event has raised over one million dollars for special purchases.

This year's top fundraising team was longtime leader Smiley Goats, led by the Jeff and Erin Horstmeyer family in memory of their son, Sammy. They raised \$7,151. #RigginsSmallButMighty#CdLS, led by the Taylor and Tiffani Hoffbeck family in honor of their son, Riggs, raised \$3,790 for second-place team. Jeff Horstmeyer was the top individual fundraiser, raising \$3,779.

The current auxiliary group, the LifeScape Ambassadors, will meet in a few weeks to review Wish List requests to decide how to distribute the funds. "There never seems to be enough money, but this year, there just might be," says Ambassador Vonny Revell. "It's so great to see

Total: \$78,914,584



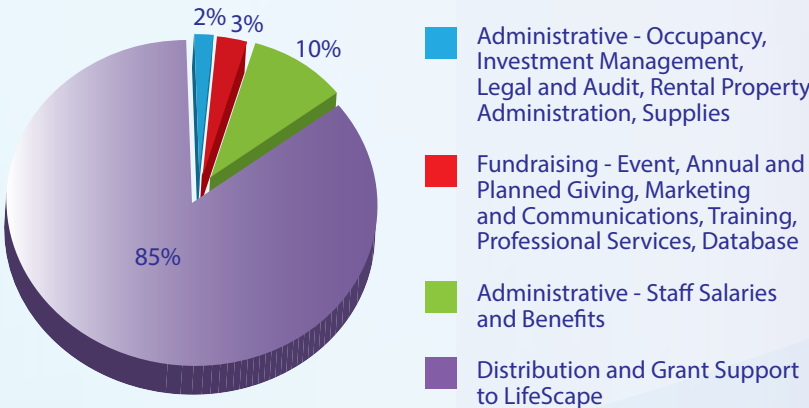

Of the total expenses, \$2,578,416 is a distribution to the service provider LifeScape. This amount is determined by the LifeScape Foundation's spending policy of distributing 4% of the 16-quarter rolling average of the endowment's market value. The policy protects the endowment from inflation, provides for endowment growth, and makes possible a distribution amount for program support. In addition, a distribution of \$2,200,000 was provided to LifeScape for the capital campaign and an additional \$1,008,676 was provided through donor-designated grant support to LifeScape..

Get a Tax Break and Income for Life

Satisfy your RMD by donating your IRA funds to LifeScape via a charitable gift annuity.

Stock portfolios saw strong increases by the end of 2023, which may have left many individuals with higher balances in their retirement accounts. That sounds great for most, although higher balances mean that retirees may have to take more out in 2024 to satisfy their required minimum distribution (RMD) if they exceed the age threshold.

What to know

Retirees with tax-deferred retirement accounts – Traditional pretax 401(k)s and IRAs – are required to start withdrawing at age 73 as of January 1, 2023 – up from 72 and 70 ½ before that. The amounts of these distributions are calculated by the account balance on December 31st, divided by the life expectancy of the individual. Due to this year’s strong performance and the increased age for RMD, some retirees must withdraw a larger percentage in 2024 because the accounts have appreciated longer, and a 73-year-old has a shorter life expectancy than someone aged 72.

With an increase in RMDs, comes an increase in the amount of money owed in taxes due to the additional taxable income. Here’s one strategy that you may want to consider when discussing your options with a trusted financial advisor to lessen a higher RMD’s impact on your specific financial situation.

Qualified Charitable Distributions

A qualified charitable distribution, or QCD, may be a great strategy to lower your adjusted gross income (AGI), satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD), and support the mission of LifeScape. Although not eligible for a charitable deduction, by lowering your AGI you could potentially reduce taxes based on income such as Social Security benefits or Medicare Parts B and D surcharges of 3.8%.

Consider instructing your retirement account custodian to transfer the funds (\$105,000 QCD limit in 2024) directly from the IRA to LifeScape. This should be coordinated in a timely manner with your account administrator to avoid a conflict of the

“first-dollars-out” rule, meaning the first dollars withdrawn from and IRA in any year are deemed to satisfy the RMD.

It is also important to note that QCDs are not permitted to be withdrawn from employer-sponsored retirement plans such as a 401(k), 403(b), etc. and must be from an IRA (including inherited IRAs). Additionally, donor-advised funds and private foundations do not qualify for QCD treatment.

IRA Charitable Gift Annuities

Under current law, IRA owners are also offered a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to use a QCD to fund a Charitable Gift Annuity (CGA) or other funding vehicles (reach out for more info). The maximum lifetime distribution of \$53,000, adjusted for inflation in 2024, allows a traditional IRA owner to fund a gift annuity held at LifeScape which then pays the donor a fixed rate set at the time of the gift. The payment continues for the term of one or two lives, depending on its setup. This is based on the donor’s age(s) and an anticipated 50/50 split of funds between the donor and the charity.

IRA gift-annuity payments are taxable at ordinary income rates. However, unlike a standard IRA withdrawal, it does not raise the donor’s AGI. As with QCDs, no tax deduction is given, but rather the IRA donation offsets the owner’s annual RMD, if required annually.

Our team at LifeScape can work with you and your financial advisor to set up a charitable gift annuity with a minimum \$25,000 initial contribution. This one-time opportunity is complex, so we urge you to discuss this with your financial and or tax professional.
